

Orlando Dressage 2010 Amateur Championships
Rules and Guidelines

In order to qualify for the Amateur Championships the following requirements must be met.

1. The same rider/horse combination is to show at 4 of the 7 shows listed.
2. Riders to be on file with the USEF/USDF as an Adult Amateur or JR/YR.
3. For Training Level thru 4th Level, the Champion and Reserve Champion will be determined by the highest average of a rider's top 4 scores within the level. You may only have one score from the beginning test of the level, for example 1st Level Test 1 may only be used once. The average score must also include at least one score of the highest test in the level, for example 1st Level Test 4.
4. The FEI Champion and Reserve Champion will be determined by the highest average of four tests of any FEI Test.
5. Opportunity Classes, Freestyles, Pas de deux, Quadrille, Young Horse Tests, or Developing Horse Tests may not be used in the average.
6. Presentation of the Champion and Reserve Champion Awards will be given at an award ceremony on March 29th during the Heidelberg Cup 2 show. Any award winners not able to be present may arrange for the awards delivery at their own expense.

The shows included as qualifiers for the Championships are:

Orlando Winter Classic - December 12-13, 2009
Ocala Winter Dressage - January 16-17, 2010
Snowbird's Paradise Show - January 30-31, 2010
Orlando Sweetheart Cup - February 13-14, 2010
Ocala Spring Dressage - March 13-14, 2010
Heidelberg Cup 1 - March 27, 2010
Heidelberg Cup 2 - March 28, 2010
