I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin,

and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK. Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("Liability") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

New USEF Rules come into affect on December 1, 2022. The rule that affects <u>Lite</u> competitions most is GR310.7 states: Membership Requirements. Any individual signing an entry blank as Trainer or Coach, must be an Active Competing Member of the Federation. 3. Safe Sport Requirements a. Any individual signing an entry blank as Trainer or Coach, must have completed the Safe Sport Training prior to the first day of competition.

Federation Horse of The Year (HOTY) Points a. For HOTY Points Associated with the Horse. Lite Competitions will award half-value points to all USEF Recorded horses, whose owner is a Federation Active Competing Member and meets any applicable breed/ discipline required memberships. b. For HOTY Points Associated with the Rider. Lite Competitions will award half-value points to all riders who are Federation Active Competing Members and meet any applicable breed/discipline required memberships.

ENTRIES: All entries must be postmarked by November 30th. Correct fees in full and a copy of a current Coggins Report (within 1 year) must accompany each entry form.

ENTRY FEES: Office Fee: \$50 per horse/rider entry.

Class Fees: Rail classes are \$35, WDAA tests \$40 per test, Traditional Dressage Tests of Choice \$40, Freestyles \$45 Non-competing horses must complete an entry & pay a \$55 schooling fee plus stall fee or trailer-in fee. Class changes approved by management: \$10.

Late Entries: All entries must be postmarked on or before the closing date. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of management and will incur a late fee of \$35.

STABLING FEES: Stalls and tack stalls will be assigned on a "first come first serve" basis by entry receipt. If requested stall area is filled, competitors will be assigned to other stall areas. Climate controlled stalls \$145. Limited high quality permanent stalls-\$125 & very nice expo stalls (10x10) with doors & rubber matting-\$110. Initial bedding (2 bags) is included. Additional bedding is available on the grounds at \$9.00 per bag. Additional nights \$30. Please no outside bedding. Some barns have apartments attached that are available to rent. Please let us know on your entry if you want to be in a particular barn or if you want to be near someone. A grounds fee of \$30 per horse per day for non-stabled horses (ship-in fee).

NO REFUNDS after the closing date. Refunds before the closing date will be issued for amount paid minus the \$50 office fee. Returned Checks will incur a \$50 return fee, if not rectified within 10 days the matter will be turned over to USEF for disciplinary action.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded first to sixth place. No ribbons or awards will be mailed unless arrangements are made through the Secretary.

LEVEL CHAMPIONS will be the highest combined average of two (2) tests at that level, one must be Test 4.

RIDE TIMES: Tentative ride times will be available online at www.orlandodressage.com by Thursday evening, December 8th. All ride times, including the pre-printed show program, are to be considered tentative until noon the day before the show day. Please check your ride times outside the office on the results board, for up-to-date times. If you don't have online availability you may call the Show Secretary at **352-406-9886** after December 8th. Show office will be open at Noon on Friday, December 9th.

FOOTING: Covered 300' x 170' arena with an improved clay/sand mixture with a matched footing schooling ring. Three outdoor fiber rings. Grass arenas may be added for warm-up if necessary.

DIRECTIONS: Finding the Grand Oaks the first time may be challenging, but soon you will realize how easy it is to find. From I-75: Take the Belleview/Dunnellon exit #341 head east on CR 484. Continue on 484 for about 8 miles. Take a right onto S Hwy 441/Hwy 27. Continue on 441 for 4 miles. Turn left onto SE 165th St/County Hwy-42. Continue for 3.8 miles. Turn right onto CR 25 go 3 miles to Griffin Road. Turn left go 1.5 miles to Grand Oaks on the left.

From Orlando area: Take Florida Turnpike (tolls) North towards Ocala . Take the US-27/FL-19 exit, EXIT 285, toward Leesburg for 21.8 miles. Turn left onto Teague Trail. Teague Trail becomes County Road 25 go approx. 1.5 miles. Turn right onto Griffin Road go 1.5 miles to Grand Oaks on the left. **.From Jacksonville area:** Take I-10 West to the US-301 exit, EXIT 343, toward Starke/Baldwin. Head south for 91.5miles. Stay straight to go onto SE Abshier Blvd/US-27 S/US-441 S/FL-25. Continue to follow US-27 S/US-441 S/FL-25 for 6.5miles. Turn left onto SE 165th St/County Hwy-42. Continue to follow County Hwy-42 for 3.8 miles. Turn right onto S Highway 25/US-27A S/US-441A S/County Hwy-25. Continue to follow US-27A S/US-441A S for 1.5 miles. Turn right onto Griffin Rd. Go 1.5 miles to Grand Oaks on the left.

FORMS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON LINE AND AT THE SHOW.

The parent, legal guardian, or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
